

Registration

Registration will take place from 13.00 to 21.00 hrs, at the Biological Research Center (BRC). The address of the BRC is: Odesszai körút 62, Szeged

Currency regulations

Foreign currency can be freely imported into Hungary, and exported if not used. Foreign currency, various cheques (please check with your bank), travellers' cheques etc. can be exchanged into Hungarian Forints (Ft) at official exchange offices. The current rate is ca. 45 Ft per U. S. dollar. Currency may be exchanged at the airport and on international trains. It is recommended not to exchange too much foreign currency initially, since a maximum of half the exchanged sum may be changed back into the original currency, or \$ 100 equivalent, whichever is less, and the import and export of more than 100 Ft is prohibited.

Visas

Please remember that citizens of many countries require visas for entering Hungary. Visas may be obtained at any Hungarian Consulate, and also upon arrival at Budapest Ferihegy Airport. Motorists may obtain their visas at the border, but railway passengers must have obtained theirs in advance.

Weather

Early September is usually warm and sunny in Szeged; light clothes are recommended.

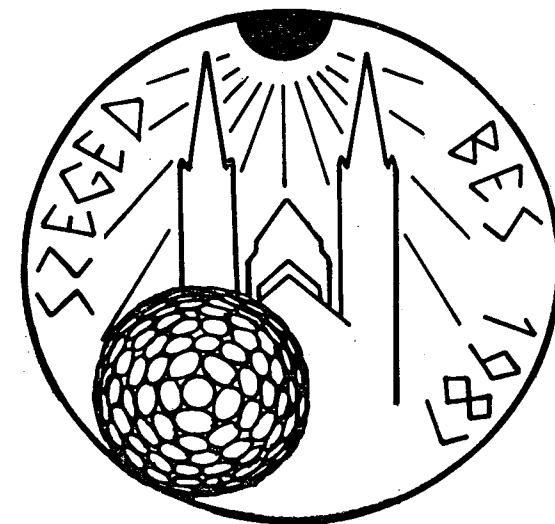

Guidelines to contributors

Oral presentation:

Projection facilities for slides mounted in 5×5 cm frames and overhead transparencies will be provided.

Fifty minutes will be available for each invited lecture, including discussion time. Other contributors will have twenty minutes including discussion time.

Posters:

A horizontal rectangle 1×2 m is available for each poster.

Szeged is a medium sized city situated in the most southern part of Hungary, on the banks of the River Tisza. After a disastrous flood in 1879, much of the city was rebuilt in the "Art Nouveau" style, thus giving it its exceptional architectural character. Many fine walks can be enjoyed along its quiet and beautiful boulevards.

Accommodation

Participants are requested to fill in the enclosed form and return it as soon as possible to the congress secretariat.

Those wishing to stay in Budapest before and after the congress may reserve hotels from abroad [several international hotel groups are represented (Hilton, Atrium Hyatt, Novotel, Penta, etc.)], or upon arrival at the airport or railway station.

Dining facilities

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served daily in the restaurant of the BRC.

Cancellations

Notification of cancellation must be sent in writing to the congress secretariat. Cancellations received before August 1 1987 will be accepted and a full refund of fees less a cancellation charge of 10% will be made. No refunds can be made for cancellations received after August 1, 1987.

How to get to the Symposium

All international flights and trains terminate in Budapest. Szeged is about 170 km south-east from Budapest. The best way to travel from Budapest to Szeged is by train: there are four expresses per day from the Nyugati railway station (see timetable below). To travel from Ferihegy (Budapest) Airport to the centre of Budapest, either take the special airport bus to Engels tér (fares: 20 Ft from Ferihegy 1 and 30 Ft from Ferihegy 2) or a taxi (fare ca. 200 Ft). The train fare to Szeged is ca. 200 Ft. A taxi all the way from the airport to Szeged will cost about 2500 Ft.
