

Dear Colleague:



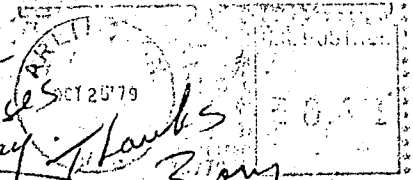
